Presidents and the Favorable ACLU Voting Percentage of the Justice(s) They Nominated

This chart shows, in order from earliest to most recent by the 19 presidents who nominated them, the percentage of each justice's votes on the side of the ACLU and how many ACLU/SCOTUS cases on which they voted.

For example, Theodore Roosevelt, No. 1 in Column A below, nominated one justice to the Court, Oliver Wendell Holmes, Jr. He voted on three ACLU cases and was on the side of the ACLU in two of those cases, or 66.67% of the time.

Warren G, Harding, president No. 4, put four justices on the

U.S. Supreme Court. Those four justices collectively voted on 20 ACLU/SCOTUS cases. Seven of those votes, or 35%, were on the same side as the ACLU.
